Day 1

Fly from selected airport to Cape Town where our guide will meet you. We travel with a luxury vehicle to Franschhoek, our first stop is the Huguenot Monument and Perfume Museum. We check into the beautiful Protea Hotel where we will be staying for five nights. The strong wine culture, and pristine natural and architectural beauty has made Franschhoek into what many describe as the "food and wine capital" of South Africa.

Day 2

After a great night's rest, we enjoy breakfast and then depart to Paarl. We will stop at the Afrikaans Language Monument which is located on a hill overlooking Paarl. Officially opened on 10 October 1975, it commemorates the semicentenary of Afrikaans being declared an official language of South Africa separate from Dutch. We depart to Babylonstoren where we then explore the 3.5-hectare garden with over 300 edible and medicinal plant varieties. We will also be partaking in the Collection Tour, Bee Focus, a wine tasting and Cellar Tour at this magnificent and most interesting stop. Return back to Franschhoek.

Enjoy a delicious breakfast before we go to Huguenot Fine Chocolates for a tour. They offer a delicious range of chocolates, made from the finest imported Belgian chocolate. Partners, Denver Windvogel & Denver Adonis are Belgian-qualified chocolatiers. To the platform we go! The wine tram is a unique and leisurely way to see the Franschhoek Valley as we journey through rolling vineyards, stopping at some of South Africa's oldest and most distinguished wine estates. Our trip takes us to Rickety Bridge where we will enjoy a lovely wine & cheese tasting (lunch own account). We travel back to the hotel where we will enjoy some leisure time before dinner at one of the lovely restaurants in town.

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Day 4

We enjoy breakfast and then travel to Stellenbosch. It's surrounded by the vineyards of the Cape Winelands and the mountainous nature reserves of Jonkershoek and Simonsberg. The town's oak-shaded streets are lined with cafes, boutiques and art galleries. Cape Dutch architecture gives a sense of South Africa's Dutch colonial history, as do the Village Museum's period houses and gardens. We do a town tour of this historic town. The Village Museum is so rich in history and the local guides are dressed in 1800's clothing, making their stories and the tour so much more set to the time era. We enjoy lunch in Stellenbosch where we can explore and snack in the most popular street of this beautiful town. What can be more than interesting than visiting Middelvlei Wine Estate where everyone will have the chance to blend their own wine. This unique experience allows you to create a personalized bottle of your own wine to take home. We will receive a selection of blending components with the challenge to create our own blend. We travel back to the hotel.

Day 5

After breakfast we travel Morgenster. The family estate lies in the heart of the Helderberg, on the foothills of the mountains where eagles carve through the sky and owls roost in trees close to the Manor House. It's the setting of our Bertrand family story. At Morgenster we do Olive oil tasting. Giulio Bertrand (the founder), is considered as the 'Father of Olive Oil' in South Africa as he paved the way for the local olive oil industry as we know it today. In 1994, he imported 17 superior Italian olive varieties, started a wonderful partnership with the Olive Oil Institute in Perugia and planted 42 hectares of olive trees on our rocky soils. The estate's first extra virgin olive oils were released into the market in 1998. Lanzerac Wine Estate is our next stop, where we will do a wine and chocolate pairing. Lanzerac Wine Estate is a historic landmark and Stellenbosch icon. The Grande dame is synonymous with old-world charm and rich Cape heritage. Positioned in the idyllic Jonkershoek Valley on the outskirts of the historical town of Stellenbosch, the Estate boasts views of dramatic mountain ranges, endless rows of lush vineyards and hectares of gardens shaded by giant Oak trees.
