Day 1

Meet us at Cape Town Airport (time to be confirmed). We travel the coastal scenic route via Gordon's Bay, Hangklip, Betty's Bay and Kleinmond to the beautiful town of Hermanus. Hermanus lies along Walker Bay on the south coast of the Western Cape. It is located about 115 km southeast of Cape Town. It was originally called *Hermanuspietersfontein*, but shortened in 1902 as the name was too long for the postal service. We make the 4 star graded Misty Waves Hotel our home for the next 5 nights. The hotel is situated in Marine Drive, overlooking Walker Bay and won the TripAdvisor Award 2019/2020, for one of the top 25 hotels in South Africa and top 10% of hotels, world-wide!

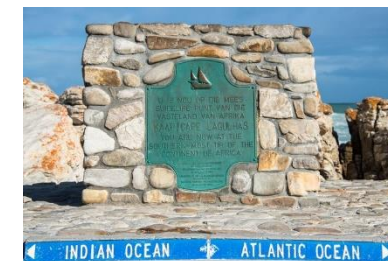

Day 2

Enjoy a delicious breakfast before we travel through the Overberg region to Bredasdorp, via Stanford. The tragic history of the Agulhas coastline is dramatically evoked at our first stop, the Shipwreck Museum. The southernmost coastline of Africa is also one of its most dangerous parts - with an estimated 250 vessels and 2 500 people lost in its waters down through the centuries. No wonder, that generations of sailors have referred to this area as the 'ships' graveyard'. It is the only museum of its kind in the southern hemisphere. The town of Bredasdorp was founded with the building of a Dutch Reformed Church in 1838 on the farm Langefontein. The town was named after Michiel van Breda, the first Mayor of Cape Town, who was also known as the father of South Africa's merino sheep industry. Van Breda and Pieter Voltelyn van der Byl could not agree on a location for the church; as a result, two churches were built, and two towns, Bredasdorp and Napier, were established. We travel to the most southern tip of Africa where the Atlantic and Indian oceans meet. Take an iconic picture with each of your feet on either side of the line. Explore the lighthouse before we travel back to Hermanus.

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Day 3

After an early breakfast, we make our way to the New Harbour. Southern Right Charters is a leading boat-based whale watching operator which has been operating since 1999. They offer boat-based whale and dolphin watching tours. They operate within the local waters of Walker Bay, regarded as one of the best whale-watching areas in the world. They are a small team with a big passion for whales and the marine environment. The company is progressive, environmentally sensitive and operates under the ethos of 'Observing NOT Disturbing'. As such, the safety and conservation of the whales and marine life is principal. The Whale & Dolphin watching permit allows us to approach the whales up to 50m, and being curious creatures, they usually come right up to the boat. After we freshen up at the hotel, we are off to the Hemel & Aarde Valley to visit a prestigious wine farm.

Day 4

Today we have an early start! With a packed breakfast to enjoy on the way, we travel via Stanford, Riviersonderend, Bonnievale, Ashton and Montagu to the Protea Farm in the Langeberg Mountain Range which overlooks the magnificent Overberg and Koo Valley. In 1985 the Protea Farm started offering the now famous Montagu Tractor Trip. The tractor, pulling its load of sightseers, meanders its way up the Langeberg Mountain, reaching an altitude of 1500m above sea level. On the way up you will have a bird's eye view of the Koo Valley and, once at the top, you can look down into the Robertson Valley. After our trip we enjoy a traditional South African "potjiekos" lunch before we travel back to Hermanus.

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Day 5

After breakfast, we once again travel to the "New Harbour" where we visit Abagold for a guided tour. Abagold cultivates Abalone, the world's most desirable seafood, in close harmony with nature. The pristine cool waters of the Atlantic Ocean provide the necessary nutrients and environment for the production of the highest quality Abalone. The Abalone species, *Haliotis Midas*, is revered around the world and is unique to our coastline. After this interesting outing, we enjoy a day of leisure in the beautiful coastal town. Enjoy the unique little shops, buy harvested Eucalyptus honey, visit the "Old Harbour" & Museum, Whale House, De Wet's House and enjoy

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lunch at any of the amazing restaurants in town. Shop until you drop! In the late afternoon, we take a scenic drive-up Rotary Way (Klein Rivier Berge) for sundowners while overlooking Walker Bay.

NOTE – we will either enjoy breakfast at the hotel or received a packed breakfast, depending on the departure time of our group flight reservation for the travelers that are flying back home.



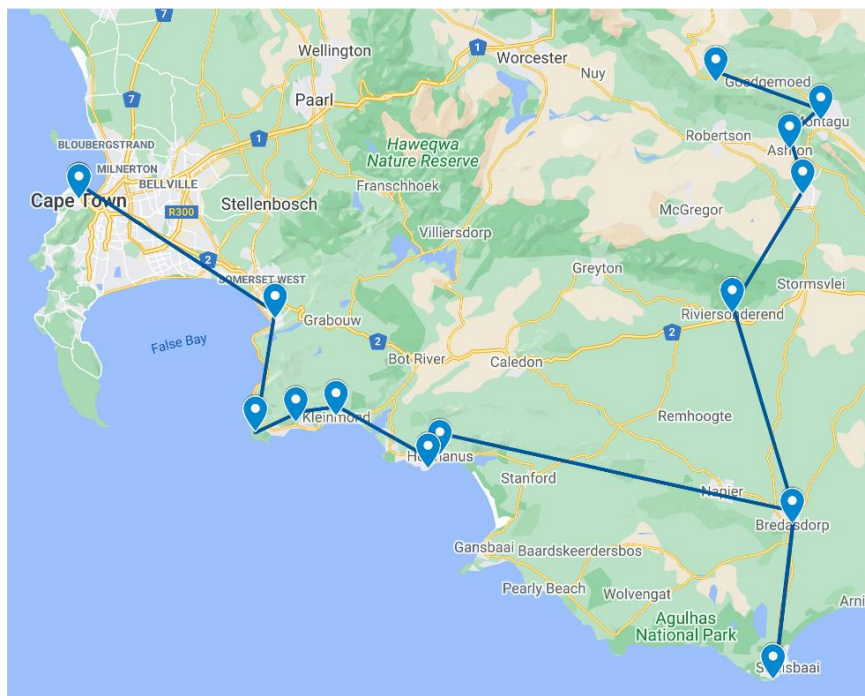
